#### **Acknowledgement**

Wright Graduate University has signed and returned to the Department of Education a Certification and Agreement to receive and use funds under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. The University is committed to using no less than 50 percent of the funds received under this section to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

#### **Total Funds Available**

The total funds the institution will receive from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement is \$5,238, of which at least \$2,619 will be awarded as Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

#### **Total Funds Distribution**

As of September 18, 2020, no aid has yet been distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. The institution is determining its methodology and application process and will allow students time to file a FAFSA in order to determine eligibility.

#### **Eligibility**

An estimated total of 24 students enrolled at the institution as of March 13, 2020, are or could be eligible to participate in the Federal student financial aid programs under Section 484 of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, and thus are or could be eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

#### **Total Students Receiving Grants**

As of September 18, 2020, 0 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

#### **Method for Determining Grant Eligibility**

As of September 18, 2020, The University is still determining its grantmaking methodology.
