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Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

Wright Graduate University prepares and develops transformational leaders and coaches through dynamic distance education. The university integrates the most effective human emergence technologies and relevant research to cultivate scholar practitioners who bring out the best in themselves and those they lead and coach. Members of the university community consciously engage in their own transformation and leadership as they coach and support others to unleash their potential for the advancement of humanity and conscious, sustainable living on the planet.

Wright Graduate University measures student achievement in terms of on-time graduation and retention rates as students and graduates pursue their personal process of transformation and facilitate the transformation of those they lead and coach. A student is deemed to have graduated on time if he or she completed within 150% of the standard program length (e.g., Master of Arts in Transformational Leadership and Coaching, a 27-month program, a graduate who completed within 40 months is said to have graduated on time).
